A First for the Archdiocese of St. Boniface – New Condos in Transcona

Affordable condominiums will see the light of day in Transcona in 2019-2020 on archdiocesan property, site of the former French parish Notre-Dame-de-l'Assomption. The idea of developing the property, located on Leola Street, was originally pitched not long after the closure of the parish on July 31, 2016. Nearly three years later, the project was presented and approved by the East Kildonan-Transcona Community Committee at its March 19 meeting. Plans to subdivide and rezone the property to allow the construction of multi-family units can now move forward.
